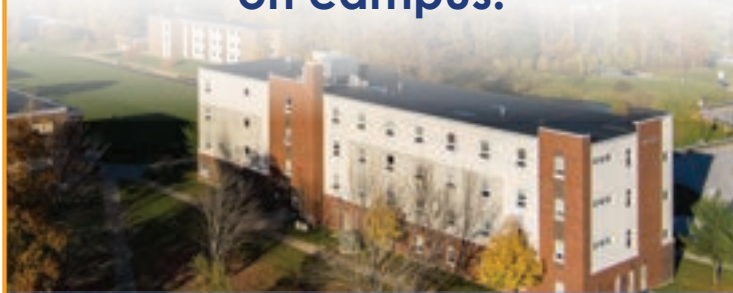

Kineo Hall houses students in “blocks” (two double-occupancy rooms with four people of the same gender) or triple-occupancy rooms. Each is individually climate controlled and shares a common bathroom, with double sinks, a shower and a toilet stall.

Acadia Hall houses students in corridor-style double or triple occupancy rooms.

A meal plan is mandatory for anyone living in residential housing on campus.
